At the request of the Cornell Middle/High School Principal, I requested a canine sniff of the school from CHSO Deputy Bloom. This was performed at 10:00am. Deputy Bloom's K9 hit on a locker that Principal Elliott informed me belonged to [REDACTED], with whom I had prior professional contact. She was brought to the office and her mother, Venus, contacted by Elliott. Elliott informed me that Venus requested no interview of [REDACTED] prior to her arrival.

Shortly after being brought to the office [REDACTED] said she needed to go to the bathroom to change her pad. This was denied by the school, and explained as an opportunity to discard contraband.

Upon Venus' arrival I activated my body camera and Venus accompanied [REDACTED] to the bathroom. When they exited Venus said she hadn't found anything. Elliott and I spoke to them in the conference room and I pointed out that based on my experience I believed [REDACTED] was engaged in this. I gave me card to Venus before she departed asking her to contact me if she had questions or there was any way I could help her dissuade [REDACTED] from further vaping and/or drug activity.

Case closed.
