

On 1/30/23 I contacted the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Internet Crimes Against Children task force and requested a telephone call. I soon thereafter received a phone call from a DCI agent out of Eau Claire and I summarized this case and another case. He said that this communication was fairly routine, but if there were signs of traveling to meet, or sextortion or email it would then be pursued.	

As there were none of these danger signs, the has been counseled and her internet access removed, this case is closed.
