INITIAL INFORMATION:

At the end of the school day on Thursday, 1/26/23, I was contacted by Principal David Elliott of the Cornell Middle/High School of a juvenile problem at the school. He informed me a female juvenile was being asked for nude photos online.

On 1/27/23 I met with Elliott and learned that [REDACTED] had been in contact via Facebook with persons requesting nude pictures. I was familiar with [REDACTED] from prior contacts, [REDACTED] Elliott supplied quick brief print-outs of concerning communications he had access to, advising these were the most concerning, but offering to send me complete information. [REDACTED]

On 1/30/23 I arrived at work and found that Elliott had emailed me additional information. He confirmed that [REDACTED] guardian, Jennifer Sturgis, had been notified and [REDACTED] internet access had been removed. He also noted that he and Assistant Administrator Braaten met with [REDACTED] to discuss internet safety.

On 1/30/23 I contacted the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Internet Crimes Against Children task force and requested a telephone call. I soon thereafter received a phone call from a DCI agent out of Eau Claire and I summarized this case and another case. He said that this communication was fairly routine, but if there were signs of traveling to meet, or sextortion or email it would then be pursued.

As there were none of these danger signs, [REDACTED] has been counseled and her internet access removed [REDACTED] this case is closed.
