INITIAL INFORMATION:

On 1/3/23 I received an emailed complaint from Principal David Elliott of Cornell Middle & High School regarding juvenile [REDACTED], found in possession of a vape pen, having been using it in the girl's bathroom. This was witnessed by staff member Deanna Hall. Elliott included a statement, non-consent, and [REDACTED] information. I did not have time on 1/3/23 to take action on the complaint.

On the morning of 1/4/23 I reviewed the complaint and returned the phone call of Elliott from earlier in the morning. I said I needed the witness statement from Deanna Hall, which Elliott emailed to me shortly after our conversation. I also asked if the school still had the vape pen, and was told they could retain possession of it until after any court proceedings. During the phone call Elliott informed me that [REDACTED] mother, Venus Hryniewiecki, would like to speak to the police regarding the matter. Elliott agreed to be part of that conversation if it was agreed upon with Venus.

Around 9:18am I telephoned Venus and left a message that I understood she wished to speak with me regarding this complaint, and left my contact information for a possible meeting either Thursday or Friday.

Case remains open.
