INITIAL INFORMATION:

On 1/3/23 I received an emailed complaint from Principal David Elliott of Cornell Middle & High School regarding juvenile form, found in possession of a vape pen, having been using it in the girl's bathroom. This was witnessed by staff member Deanna Hall. Elliott included a statement, non-consent, and information. I did not have time on 1/3/23 to take action on the complaint.
