Supplemental Narrative 10/10/2024 22:52:57 Andrew Holty

On Thursday, October 10, 2024 at approximately 2024hrs, I, Officer Andrew Holty was made aware of a juvenile complaint which was reported by staff of Stanley-Boyd High School. I was advised that a 9th grade student identified as **Generative Methods** (G.S.) had made a statement toward other students on the school bus similar to that of, "If only I had my Glock."

I made contact with Stanley-Boyd High School Principal Tanya Mahr and success coordinator Nathan Steinmetz, who were still at the school for an athletic event. They advised that they were made aware of an incident from the school bus director, Mr. Tiry. They reviewed the video footage captured on the bus cameras which showed G.S. sitting near another female student and touching her hair. It appeared that the female student, who was identified as the female student by the name of (M.W.) was sitting nearby and attempted to help deflect G.S.'s attention from the girl.

After a short time, G.S. began to engage M.W. G.S. appeared to be harassing him at this point. M.W. appeared to have had enough and began throwing punches at G.S., knocking him to the floor of the bus until they were eventually separated.

I was advised that this occurred on the road while the bus was transporting children back home at the end of the school day. It is believed at this point that the bus was outside of the jurisdiction of the City of Stanley, between the Village of Boyd and City of Stanley In Chippewa County.

I was advised by Mahr and Steinmetz that they reviewed the camera footage and it appeared that was antagonizing E.H. and M.W. I was also informed that there were underlying mental health issues concerning G.S. and that he had an IEP.

Due to the statement regarding, "If only I had my Glock," the school district would be conducting a threat assessment as well as entertaining other sanctions.

Both students' parents were notified of what occurred and both M.S. and G.S. will not be allowed in school on Friday, October 11, 2024. Mahr advised that she had spoken to G.S.'s mother and step-father who advised that there were guns in the home but they were locked in a safe and that G.S. did not have access to them. I was also advised that the school would be meeting with G.S. and his parents the following Monday in order to speak about the process of allowing him back at the school.

I advised Mahr and Steinmetz that I would document the initial complaint and pass it onto the Chippewa County Sheriff's Office due to jurisdiction. I also advised that I would make the incoming officer (Sgt. Adam Kuechenmeister) aware of the complaint in the event more information or follow-up was needed. Mahr advised that the Superintendent (Jeff Koenig) was made aware of the situation and that correspondence would be sent out to school staff and parents for the sake of transparency. Supplemental Narrative 10/14/2024 17:16:32 Andrew Holty

On Monday, October 14, 2024 at approximately 1520hrs, I, Officer Andrew Holty with Stanley Police Department, spoke with Mahr who stated that the school was handling the student's reentry procedure and that G.S. was scheduled to return to school on Tuesday, October 15, 2024. I was advised that the school would be implementing new procedures with G.S., which included bag checks in the morning as well as other school sanctions.

At this time, Mahr advised that the school was not requesting further law enforcement assistance. The parents and student will also be seeking further assistance to better manage G.S.'s mental health and behavioral issues. This is all the information I have at this time. Holty -248
